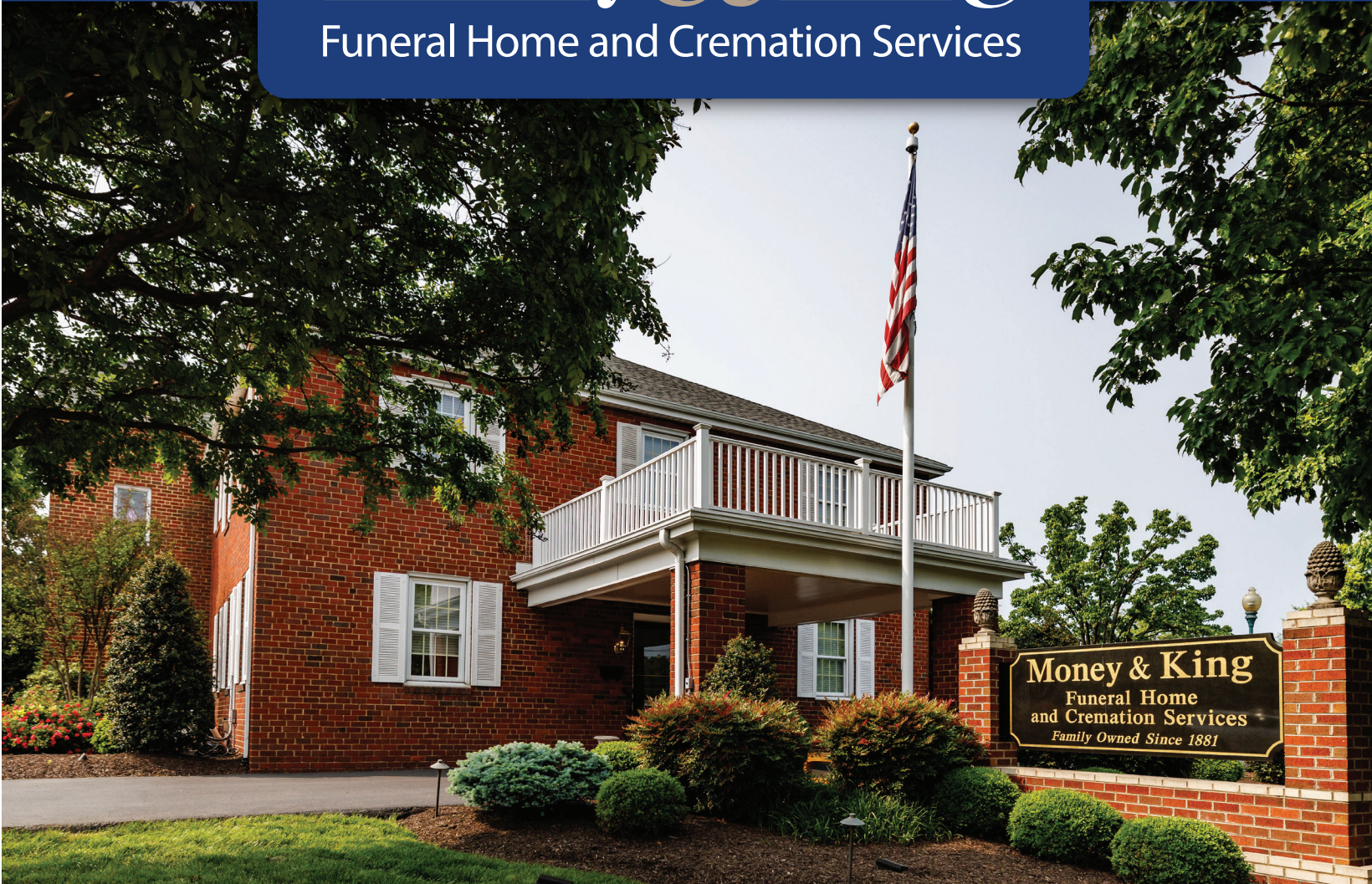

However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery or crematory services, flowers and newspaper notices. The prices for these items will be shown on your bill or the statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Certain funeral services may be provided off-premises by other funeral service providers.

Professional Services

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES of Funeral Director and Staff \$3,075.00
Our professional service charge includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; consultation with family and/or responsible parties; care and custody of the body until final disposition; personnel available 24 hours per day, 365 days per year to respond to calls and inquiries; coordinating service plans with the cemetery, crematory, church, vault companies, airlines, and others as required; preparation and filing of necessary certificates and permits; use of website; placement of death notices and obituaries. This fee also includes overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance, equipment, utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, inventory costs and government compliance.

This fee for basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select.
(This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.)

This fee is a NON DECLINABLE item.

EMBALMING (Universal Precautions Apply)\$925.00
Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

It is the policy of MONEY & KING FUNERAL HOME not to have open casket viewings without embalming.

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME \$5,145.00
Our charges include Professional Services of Funeral Director and Staff, embalming, transfer of remains to our funeral home, and transportation to the airport. This charge applies to shipment within the U.S. only.

RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME\$2,840.00
Our charges include Professional Services of Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of remains to our funeral home, and funeral coach to the cemetery.

**Does not include any funeral home facility and staff charges, services, dressing, casketing, merchandise, or cash advance items.*

IMMEDIATE BURIAL(Ranges in price from \$4,220.00 to \$16,220.00)
Our charges include Professional Services of Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of remains to our funeral home, placement of body in the casket and funeral coach to the cemetery.

DIRECT CREMATION (Range in price from \$4,170.00 to \$16,170.00)
Our charges include Professional Services of Funeral Director and Staff, transfer of remains to funeral home and crematory fee. It does not include embalming, services of funeral director and staff for viewing or funeral service or both, medical examiner fee, or merchandise.

State and local laws do not require a casket for direct cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering.) The containers we provide are made of fiberboard.

The Virginia Board of Funeral Directors and Embalmers requires that we transport the deceased to a crematory in a covered container that is rigid, combustible, and leak-and spill-resistant.
